#### Southern Cross Endurance Ride

The Southern Cross Endurance Ride is a challenge to support the Southern Cross Fund—a fund established to support riders who, after an accident do not have sufficient funds for medical expenses, recovery or rehabilitation.

The adventure itself, i.e. 2030 km in maximum timespan of 33 hours, is of course the attraction for the riders. The route is in the shape of a cross:

Windhoek to Mariental and back

Windhoek to Gobabis and back

Windhoek to Otjiwarongo and

Windhoek to Karibib and back
Windhoek to Dordabis and back

The distance can be completed in three categories, i.e.

Between 24 and 27 hours—Gold

Between 27 and 30 hours—Silver

Between 30 and 33 hours—Bronze

It is an endurance ride, and not a race, testing man/woman and machine, both physically and mentally.

We accept that this is not everybody's cup of tea and everyone can donate toward the Fund, or sponsor one of the riders per kilometer because the Fund is For Bikers—By Rikers

We know that the riders undertaking the ride need support—even if it is just a friendly smile and an offer to rub sore shoulders. To this end, the HOG Namibia Chapter hub will be at the Shell Service Station in the Lafrenz Centre, where you are cordially invited to drop in, or stay as long as you want. We will have a 24 hour vigil there in support of the riders and a call centre if support is needed along the routes.

We want to extend our sincere appreciation to Shell Energy who have come on board and are supporting this endurance ride by providing logistical support, supporting the riders as and when they enter the Shell service stations en-route, and may even sponsor some of the fuel consumption of the riders.
